

How Much is a Human Life Worth? Exodus 1:16-17 & 1:22-2:10

How much is a human life worth? The value God places on human life can be seen in the story of the birth of Moses.

The growth of Israel and their sense of ethnic identity caused
Pharaoh to consider them a threat. He devised a diabolical plan—to
every Israelite baby boy. The execution of innocent, foreign
infants was too for the ancient Egyptians to tolerate. When the
2 midwives defied his order, Pharoah openly ordered all Egyptians to
throw Israelite baby boys in the Nile. But one mother saw the
