Exodus 1:16-17 & 1:22-2:10

How much is a human life worth? The value God places on human life can be seen in the story of the birth of Moses.

The growth of Israel and their sense of ethnic identity caused Pharaoh to consider them a threat. He devised a diabolical plan—to _____ every Israelite baby boy. The execution of innocent, foreign infants was too _____ for the ancient Egyptians to tolerate. When the 2 midwives defied his order, Pharaoh openly ordered all Egyptians to throw Israelite baby boys in the Nile. But one mother saw the tremendous, potential _____ of one baby.

God _____ this mother who protected the life of her baby boy—an act that put her and her people at great risk. She _____ God and _____ Moses' life.

The record of Moses' birth is but one of many windows in Scripture that allows us to see that God places a _____ on life and works against the inclinations and intentions of the evil one to _____, steal, and _____ life rather than save it.

God created life. Human life was the crown of His creation. Genesis teaches that after every breath you take, you _____ the breath of God. Every move you make, you bear the _____ of God.
